Official Rules

The event will be governed by International Federation Petanque rules

(https://www.petanque-england.uk/wpcontent/uploads/2021/06/Official_Rules_Petanque-En.pdf) except as modified herein.

Format:

Competition in men's and women's singles, and men's and women's doubles. As per the official rules, during competition, competitors may not move boules even if they are not going to count in scoring.

In the preliminary round, we play a Swiss system with winner-take-all groups. This is a tournament format in which teams or individual players of equal strength always play against each other. The first round is a random draw. In the subsequent rounds, teams or players with the same number of wins always play against each other.

Only competitors are allowed on the playing field during competition. Spectators, coaches, etc. must stay off the playing area at all times.

We can't wait to see you in Dresden and celebrate the spirit of transplant together!
